January God Time K-1st Week 4



Hey parents! God time cards are meant to help engage families in conversation about their faith all week long!

Day 1

Cheerful Giver

Ask an adult to help you look up and read 2 Corinthians 9:7.

This verse tells us to give what you have decided in your heart to give. If you don't want to give, you shouldn't. God doesn't force us to give. He wants us to give with a great attitude.

REMEMBER, God loves a cheerful giver.

Day 2

Generosity Treasure Chest

Find an old shoebox. Color and decorate the box as a treasure chest. Write our monthly memory verse, 1 Timothy 6:18, on it. Fill your treasure chest up with ways to be generous. Ask for suggestions from another adult, a sibling or a friend. Continue filling your generosity treasure chest until it's full!

PRAY and ask God to help you to be a cheerful giver.

Day 3

We Have a Helper

Can you think of a time when you didn't show generosity to someone? How did it make the other person feel? How do you feel when someone isn't generous to you?

Sometimes it's tough to be generous when other people aren't. Next time this happens, ask God to help you to **CHOOSE** to be generous no matter what!

Ask God to help you show generosity even when it's tough.

Day 4

Surprise!

There are lots of people that we don't get a chance to show a great giving attitude toward. Have you ever thought about showing generosity to the person that delivers mail or packages or even the person that picks up trash every week?

Now is your chance to show them some unexpected generosity. Ask an adult to help you find a piece of poster board and some markers or crayons. Now, decorate your poster with a kind message and put it in your window so everyone can experience an extra dose of generosity today!

Pray and ask God for more chances to show generosity in unexpected ways.
