ICEBREAKER

Introduction

- Pastor Mike shared the quote from our church overseer Dino Rizzo, “We want to do all that we can to PLUNDER HELL, and to POPULATE HEAVEN!” Do you ever consider the long term, eternal impact of your decisions? Why or why not?

God Has Done Great Things Here!

- What’s your Jesus story? Tell the story about what God has done for you.
- What’s your LifePoint story? What has God done for you, through your church?
- What does it look like for you to share your Jesus/LifePoint story with people who are in or out of the faith? Give an example if you have one.

We Believe God Will Do More!

- Do you find yourself frustrated with the growth of our city and our church? How are you embracing it or how can you change your perspective?
- Take out your Bible and read Matthew 16:15-18. As we believe God is able to do more, we must first figure out who Jesus is to us personally. Who is Jesus to you?
- What are you excited for God to do next? What have you been praying for?

We All Have a Part to Play!

- Read Luke 19:10. What does seeking and saving the lost look like in your life, outside of how you serve at LifePoint Church? What opportunities do you have to reach people in your everyday life and do you seize them?
- How willing are you to seek the lost? In what ways are you intentional in keeping the heart of the Good Shepherd in Luke 15:1-7?

Pastor Mike shared the illustration of the Forward Dining Table - The guests we want to invite into our church. The seats we want to fill are:

- 1st seat - The Lost Person (Agnostic, atheist, no church background)
 - 2nd seat - The Next Generation (Kids, Students, College/Young Adult)
 - 3rd seat - The Prodigal Person (Walked away from faith)
 - 4th seat - The Believer (Ready to make a difference and be a part)
- Which person at the table do you identify with the most? Which person do you have the biggest heart for? Or do you have a heart for a seat that isn't listed?
 - As Pastor Mike has said, the fifth seat at the table is for us. What are some struggles/insecurities/fears that you face in saying you're willing to pay the bill?

ACT ON IT



ENCOURAGE

Philippians 4:17 reads, "Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that increases to your credit." This is the heart of what we're doing. It's not about what we give, it's about our willingness to give something that will make a difference that lasts forever. Our community is growing and we have the opportunity to help those who are coming know Jesus! We're building a church for those who have left the church. The Forward campaign isn't to make more of LifePoint, it's to advance the mission of Jesus of seeking and saving the lost. We're building a church for the next generation. Your kids, grandkids, and everyone thereafter will have a place to grow their faith. We get to be a part of creating the Forward dining table. We get to pick up the tab to make sure all those people at the table get fed. Are you going to raise your hand and pick up the check?



ASK

What great things has God done in your life? How do you want to impact Heaven? How does it make you feel knowing that God has more great things in store, and you get to be a part of it? What's standing in the way of your commitment to the Forward campaign? What would God have you give back to Him? Will you do your part to fill and serve one of those seats at the Forward dinner table?



CHALLENGE

Tell God, "Lord, everything I have belongs to you already. How would you like me to give away your money?" Finalize your plans and make your commitment to the Forward campaign this week. Then, do something kind for someone this week that will show them the love of God?

PRAAYER

God, thank you for bringing us to this Forward campaign table. You've done such great things in our lives. We never imagined being where we're at right now, but You had a plan. God, we thank you that we get to be a part of something bigger than us. We get to be a part of a God-size project. We get to do something now that will have an impact that lasts for eternity. Call us, equip us, empower us with Your Spirit to move. Give us hearts like the Good Shepherd to pray and seek the one that's coming to fill that seat at the new building. It's a blessing to be a part of the labor of seeking the lost. Help us sacrifice our comforts to make a difference that will last for eternity. Meet us where we're at and provide the resources so we can be a part of You doing great things. We ask all of this in Your Name, Amen.

Introduction

- God has been able to do so much through our church over the past five years. What else are you praying for our church to accomplish over the next five years? Are you praying for the generations to come?
- How do you feel about the season that the church is going into? Excited? Scared??

We Give because GOD Stirs Us to Give!

- Do you understand the purpose for this new house? What is it?
- God told the Israelites to bring their gold, silver and bronze. Bring their fine cloth and best building materials. If you have jewelry and gem stones, bring that. If you are a craftsman, come ready to make an amazing place for God. So, what can YOU bring to help build God's house?
- The modern-day equivalent of the offering to build the temple would be if we all started going through our own houses to see what we have to give. This probably makes some of us a little uneasy. Why do you suppose that is? What would it look like to shift your heart to a place of generosity?
- Have you ever been given a gift and you felt that the person was hesitant to give it? How did it make you feel? If you feel hesitant to give, why do you feel that way?
- Aside from finances, what gifts do you have to give to contribute to this campaign?
- Do you see this opportunity to be involved as an honor or a burden? Why?

We Build at the Speed of Your Generosity!

- Moses didn't have to ask again. The people just kept giving, and giving and giving. A spirit of generosity swept through the camp. They didn't just give ONCE, they kept looking for MORE ways to give! And they gave EVERY DAY, and they gave FREELY! What would you do if you saw the physical manifestation of everyone bringing their offerings for the temple? Would you be moved to go find a way to be a part of that? Why or why not?
- Are you willing to be obedient to what God is asking you to give and give it freely?
- This building campaign is ongoing. How can you continue to find ways to contribute instead of a one-and-done donation?

QUESTIONS CONTINUED

- If 4,000 people attend LifePoint and each one of them gave just \$4 per day for the next three years, we would have this need 100% met. For less than a cup of coffee at Starbucks, we would have raised \$18 million for the completion of God's plan. Now, not everyone can afford \$4. Some can afford less or more. How much would God have you give in order to accomplish His plan to build this temple?
- Do you feel important to this plan? Do you know why you matter? Why or why not?
- Have you thought about how it might affect the plan if you didn't get involved? We cannot do it without you!

God Will SURPRISE US When We ALL PARTICIPATE!

- There was such a spirit of generosity, Moses had to command the people NOT TO GIVE ANYMORE!! I'm telling you - that's not because of MOSES! That's not because the PLANS were that impressive. This happened because GOD STIRRED ALL THE PEOPLE, and ALL THE PEOPLE did what GOD SAID to do! Have you ever been a part of something like this? Describe a time when God used you or someone you know to accomplish great things for His plan.
- Imagine Pastor Mike getting up on a Sunday morning and saying, "OK people! Enough! Stop bringing money for the BUILDING! Stop bringing your stuff. We've got more than enough to do everything God has put in our hearts to do. You have to stop with all this giving. No more! We don't NEED it!" People would be talking about it all over the city. In fact, they'd be talking about it all over the nation. How can we get this movement started, and how can we keep it going? (Weekly updates in the service? Maybe a big thermometer in the lobby with our goal at the top?)
- A building is just a tool. It is not holy until it is filled with the glory of God! Pastor Mike said he prays, "Lord, let it happen again. Holy Spirit fall on our TINY TOWN ROAD campus! Let them have powerful encounters with your presence. We're building the place, now we ask You to fill it!" How will you be praying for this campus?
- When is a time where God surprised you after you gave something that you thought you couldn't afford to lose? Do you think God can do the same for our church if we're obedient?

ACT ON IT



ENCOURAGE

We're on mission to build for the people who are coming, for more people to hear the Gospel of Jesus. One of the most exciting parts of all of this is knowing that people we haven't even met yet will come to know God because of our faithfulness and obedience. We get to serve the next generation now! Building God's House is an all play. We're all called to be a part of this plan, but we have to decide to listen and respond as God calls us. When we respond to God in obedience, He responds to us in abundance. He takes care of our needs and some! Everything we have belongs to God anyway, so continue praying and asking Him what He wants you to do with His money. We're going to be surprised at what God does when we all decide to participate.



ASK

How is God stirring your heart to participate in the Forward campaign? Have you asked Him to move and stir you? Are you willing to aggressively give whatever you can give? Time, talents, money, etc? What are you willing to give? Remember, God isn't after your money, He's after your heart. Your heart is what matters most. What's keeping you from committing? What does your part in the Forward campaign look like? Have you been discussing Commitment Sunday with your family?



CHALLENGE

Gather with your family up everyday this week and together pray "Lord, everything I have belongs to you already! How would you like me to give away YOUR money?" Continue to pray by yourself as well. After that, think about how you as a family can save \$4 a day for the next three years to give towards the Forward campaign. How would you keep track of it?

PRAYER

God, You know the plans that our church has ahead. Building this new location isn't for us, it's to make more of You. We want to reach more people for the Gospel. This is Your plan and desire. We thank you for the Israelites' amazing story of generosity. They were so motivated by the vision shared by Moses, and their hearts were stirred so much. They were excited to be a part of something bigger than. We ask you to fill us with the same spirit of excitement and generosity. Help us be a generous people who can't wait to build Your church. Stir our hearts not only to give but towards Your Mission. What do You want us to do? Everything we have comes from You, so what do You want us to do with Your money? Let our hearts lead in how we give to this campaign. We know You will surprise us with how You respond to our obedience.

ENCOURAGE

The Mission of God is always to seek and save lost people. Jesus was only about the Father's business, so as Christ followers, we're about what Jesus is about. The mission never changes. Everything we do is to help lead people to be fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ. It's what drives us to do new things. It's easy to keep things the same and get comfortable, but God didn't call us to be comfortable. He's called us to go and make disciples. So ask Him to show you how you're going to help in the building of God's House.

ASK

- What excites you the most about the Forward campaign?
- What will be your part in helping with the Forward campaign? What can you do now in preparation for the new campus?
- This is an all-play for our church. What would it look like to get your whole family involved with the campaign?



CHALLENGE

Take a look at the five takeaway statements of what God needs from us: Attend faithfully, Pray consistently, Serve with gladness, Invite people to your church, and Give generously and sacrificially. Which areas do you need to get serious about? For the next two weeks, get bold and dangerous and pray: "Lord, everything I have belongs to you already! How would you like me to give away YOUR money?" Ask the Lord to show you how He wants you to join our three-year FORWARD campaign.
