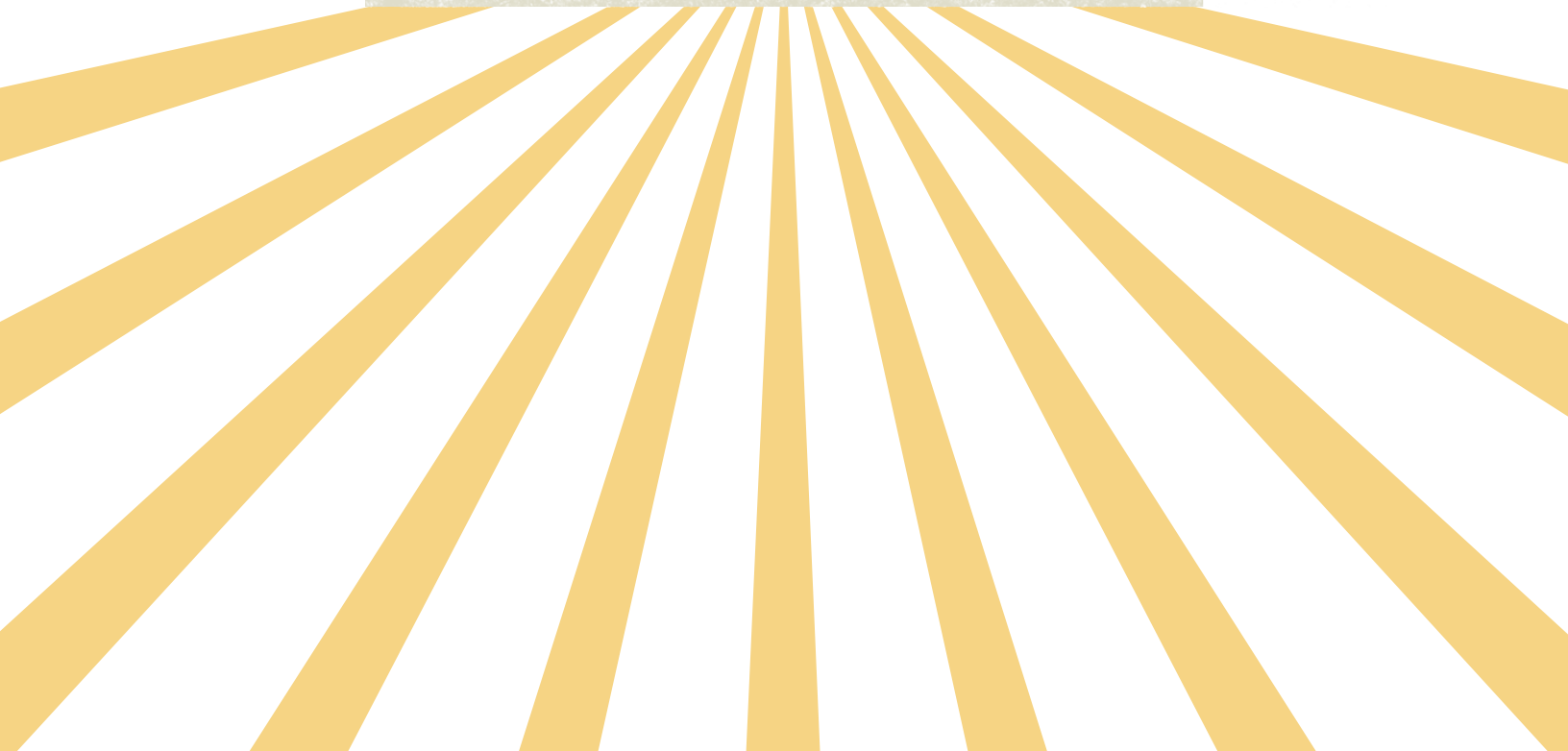

Is your family a “matching outfit for Easter” or an “every man for themselves” family?

Introduction

- If you are a believer, where did you first meet Jesus?
- The power of the Resurrection means that you don't have to live your old life anymore, you can live a new life in Jesus. What does the word resurrection mean to you?

Only Dead Things can be Resurrected

- For something to resurrect, it must die. Other than Jesus, which resurrection story is your favorite? Or do you know of others?
- Why do you think Jesus performed resurrections among his other miracles?

Eternal Life Requires the Death of Jesus!

- How would your view of sin change if you had to offer your own sacrifice once a year?
- No one comes to the Father but through Jesus. What are different ways you have tried, or have seen others, try to come to God?

Eternal Life Demands the Death of You!

- What is the one thing that keeps you up at night? Or, what sin or unforgiveness are you holding on to?
- If we die with Christ, then live with him; Does your walk with Him reflect you being a new creation? Explain.

New Life is our Way Of Life, Because of the Resurrection of Jesus

- What are ways you have walked in the “newness of life”?
- Do you feel like you are worthy of the gift of the resurrection?



ACT ON IT



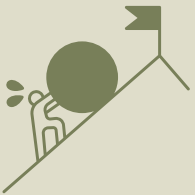
Encourage
