3. How can we take good care of our bodies as the place God's Spirit dwells and makes His home?

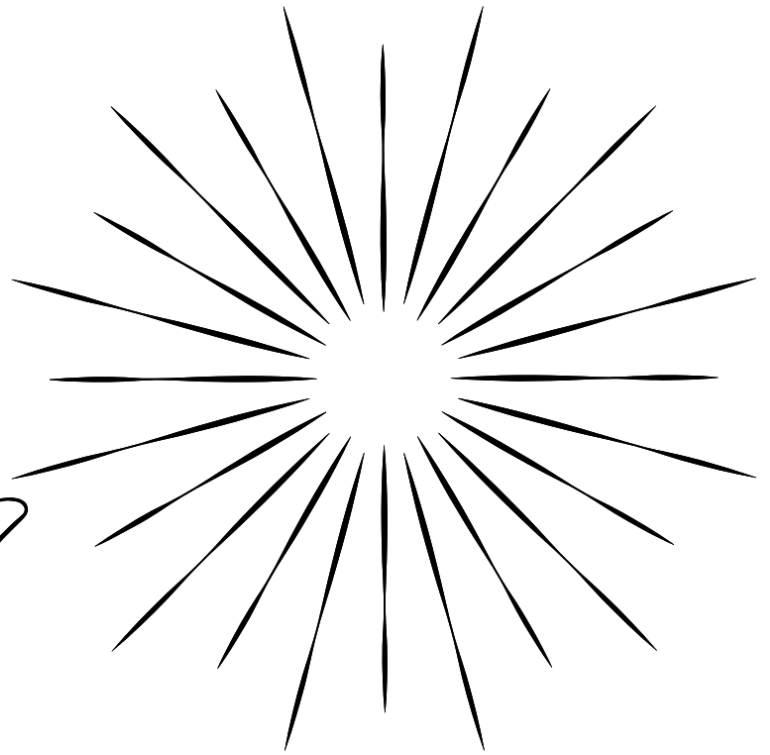

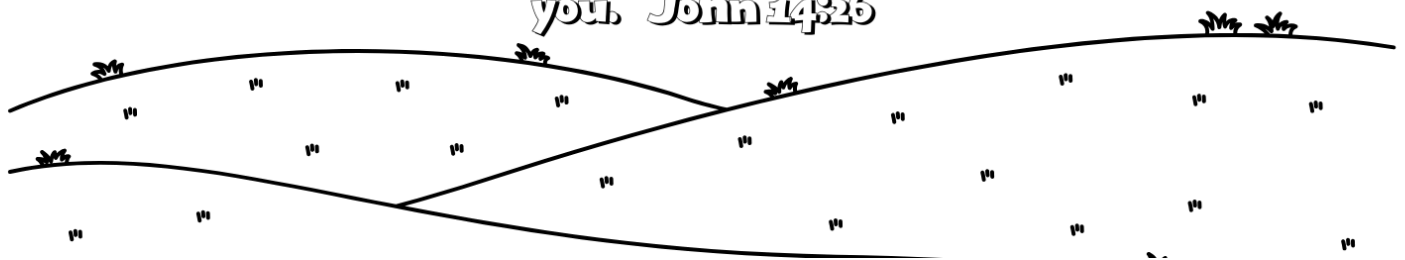

WHAT WE'RE LEARNING

3. What's one thing you could do this week to grow in your friendship with the Holy Spirit?

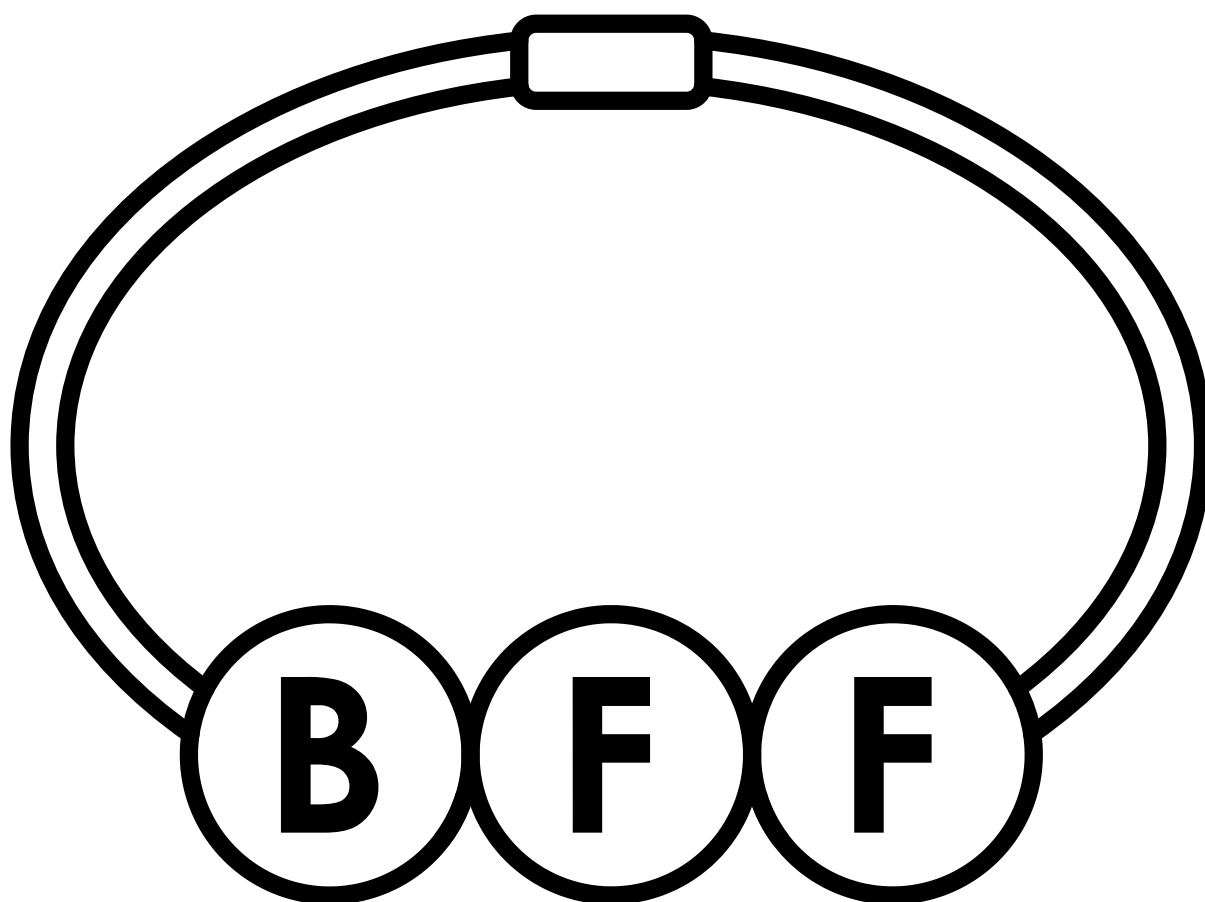

WHAT WE'RE LEARNING

3. Why do you think God gave us the Holy Spirit as a helper, instead of making us figure things out on our own?

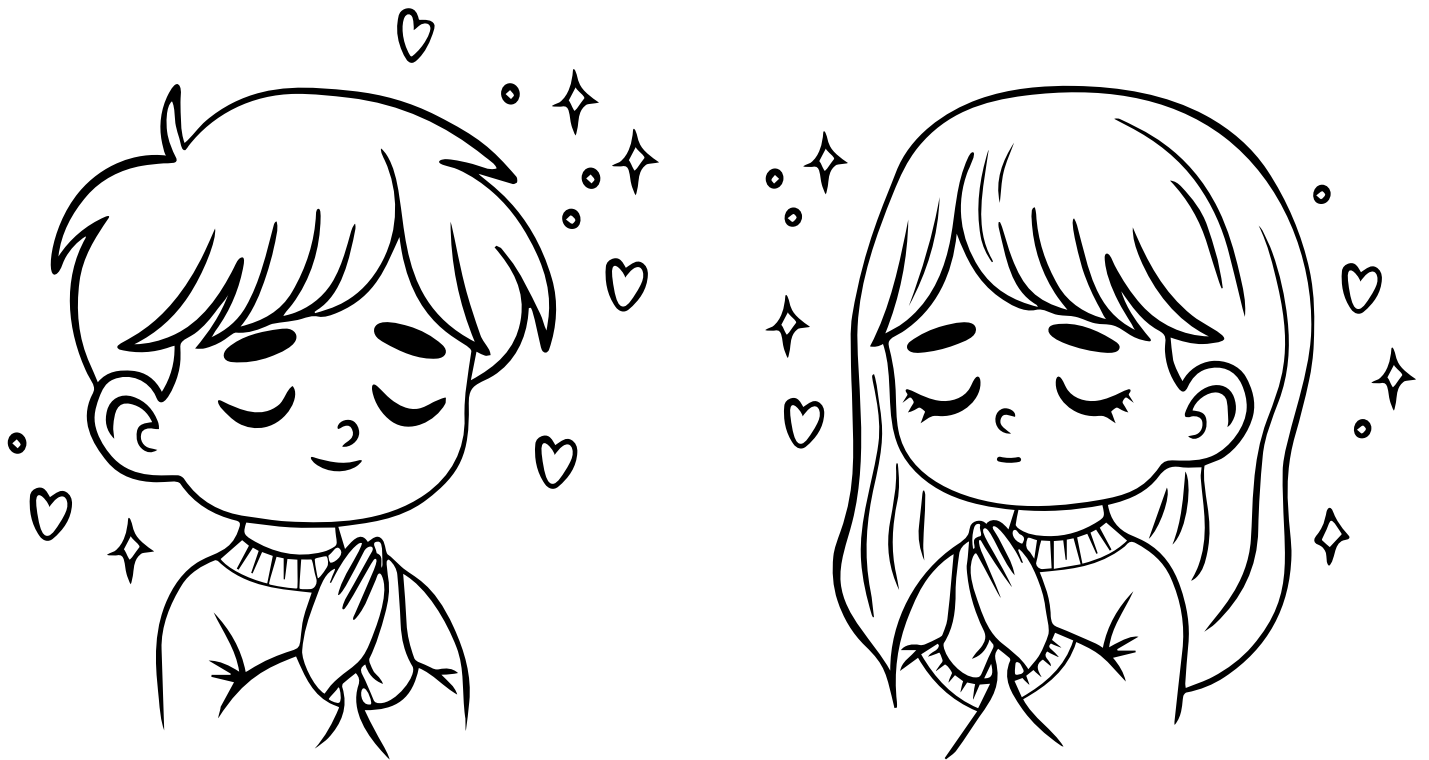
