"Faithful to Christ to the Finish" 2 Timothy 4.9-22

ICEBREAKER

HAVE YOU EVER WALKED OUT OF A MOVIE THEATER WITHOUT FINISHING THE MOVIE? IF SO, WHICH ONE? IF NOT, WHICH MOVIE DO YOU REGRET WATCHING?

RELATIONSHIPS COME AND GO (2 TIMOTHY 4:9-13)

- Have you ever been abandoned by someone in your life?
 If so, how did it affect you? How do you think it affected
 Paul?
- Who is the Luke in your life who stands beside you in tough times? How does it impact your life to have someone like this?
- We've all had relationships in our life that have struggled and that we've been hurt by. Who is someone that you've had a falling out with that you need to forgive? How can you start that process?
- Have you ever been left behind because you were unwilling to move forward?
- Pastor Beau said "Don't let relational instability shake you from your purpose." Why is it so tempting to allow broken relationships to define or derail us from our purpose? Are you currently struggling with this?

TRUST GOD OVER EVERYTHING (2 TIMOTHY 4:14-18)

- What does it look like to let God be your defender instead of taking things into your own hands?
- When you're going through hurt or hard times, do you obsess over whys or let God teach you in the situation?
- When you're hurting, how can you tell the difference between responding out of emotion or with spiritual discernment?
- God doesn't always rescue you from the pain but he always walks with you through it. Who is God calling you to reach, even in your pain? What message is your life proclaiming right now?
- Think of a time when God stood up for you. Is knowing that truth enough for you to trust God in every situation?

FINISH WITH GRACE (2 TIMOTHY 4:19-22)

- Faithfulness to Christ isn't just about what you do-it's about who you equip. Who are you purposely training up to continue what you can't finish? If you don't have one in mind, who could you start training up today?
- Are you staying faithful, even when people leave? Are you trusting God, even when you're wounded? How can we be more intentional about running this race with grace?
- What might people say at your funeral? What would you want them to say? What might you need to change?



ENCOURAGE

Do you carry the burden of vengeance on your own because pain does not cancel your purpose. If you've still got breath, grace is still available. God has a purpose for your life, so walk in that purpose according to what He has places in you. Stay on mission. God has your back.



ASK

Pastor Beau finished the sermon encouraging us to finish strong. So, ask yourself- Are you staying faithful, even when people leave? Are you trusting God, even when you're wounded? Are you finishing with grace—or with regret? Trust in God in everything, let him strengthen you to proclaim the message and stay on mission.



CHALLENGE

People will leave. Some will stay. Some will come back. And that's okay. Be faithful—don't let relational instability shake your purpose. Trust God over everything. Reach out to someone, call or text, to let them know how they have made an impact on your life.

PRAYER

Lord, I honor you first, then all the people in my life who have granted me grace and have given me words of encouragement. Heavenly Father, it's comforting to know that I am never alone and that you walk with me even when I feel abandoned and broken-hearted. I am so grateful that I have a comforter and I am not alone.
