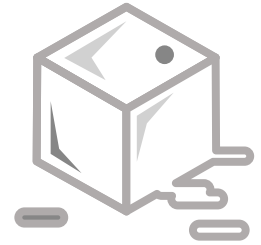

UNDERSTANDING HONOR

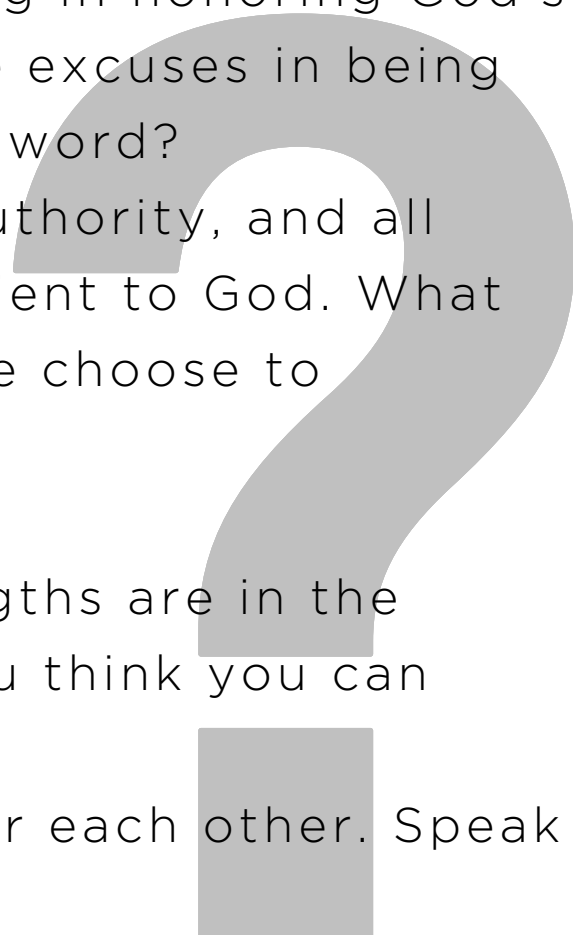
- Honor means to value, respect, or highly esteem; to treat as precious, weighty or valuable. Dishonor means to treat with contempt, to devalue, to treat as common or ordinary. Describe a time when you were either honored or dishonored by someone. How did it make you feel and how did it change the way you treat others?
- When have you had to show honor to someone's leadership position who had lost your respect due to their behavior?
- Why is it so hard for us to show honor to those who offend us?
- What is your default setting: To honor or dishonor someone? Think driving, sports games, everyday life activities.

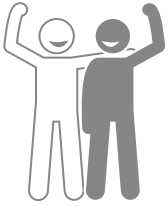
Who We are Called to Honor

- Consider whether or not the things you do in your everyday life bring the Lord honor, or dishonor. Does your “word & deed” give value, respect, and high esteem to Jesus as the Lord of your life? If not, why are we still doing that thing?
- What are ways you are winning in honoring God’s Word? How do we remove the excuses in being disobedient and honoring the word?
- Honoring God, God’s Word, authority, and all people is a choice to be obedient to God. What are we being obedient to if we choose to dishonor anything listed?

Choosing a Life of Honor

- Where do you feel your strengths are in the virtue of honor? Where do you think you can improve?
- Go around the room and honor each other. Speak life over each other.





ENCOURAGE

Let's outdo one another in honor! And Jesus is the motivation for this. He honors all of us in OFFERING HIMSELF and offering the only pathway to God, even when we don't deserve it! God always values you and me, and we get to live out a life of honor because he did it first!



ASK

Ask yourself what you are willing to change and things you are not willing to change. Then ask the Holy Spirit to reveal where He is wanting you to grow in the virtue of honor.



CHALLENGE
