CONVERSATION STARTERS

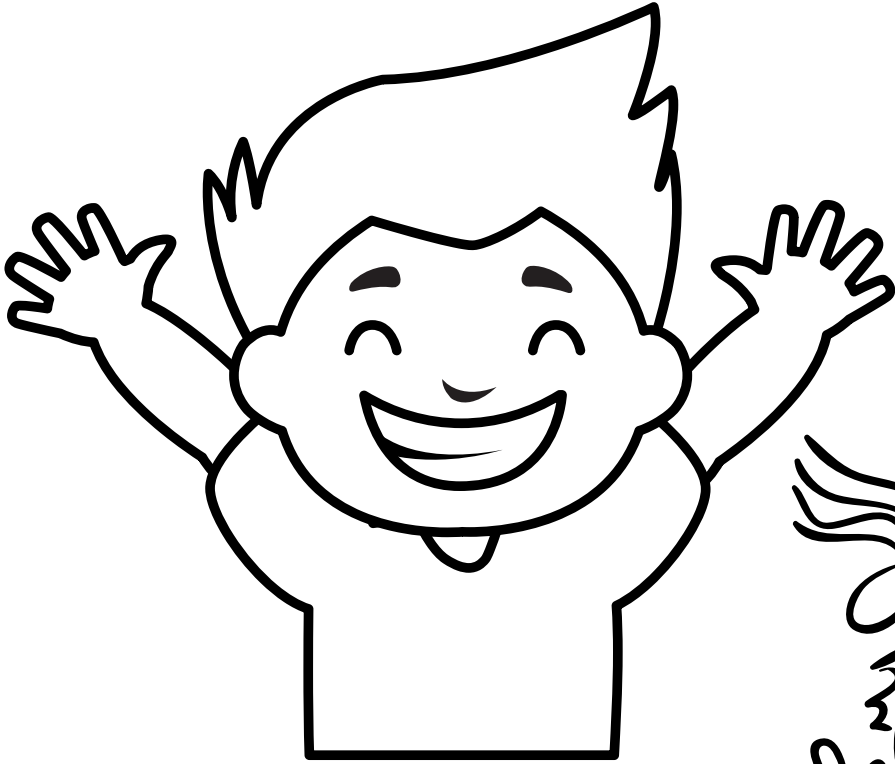
1. How does it make you feel knowing that God made you and knew you BEFORE you were even born?

CONVERSATION STARTERS

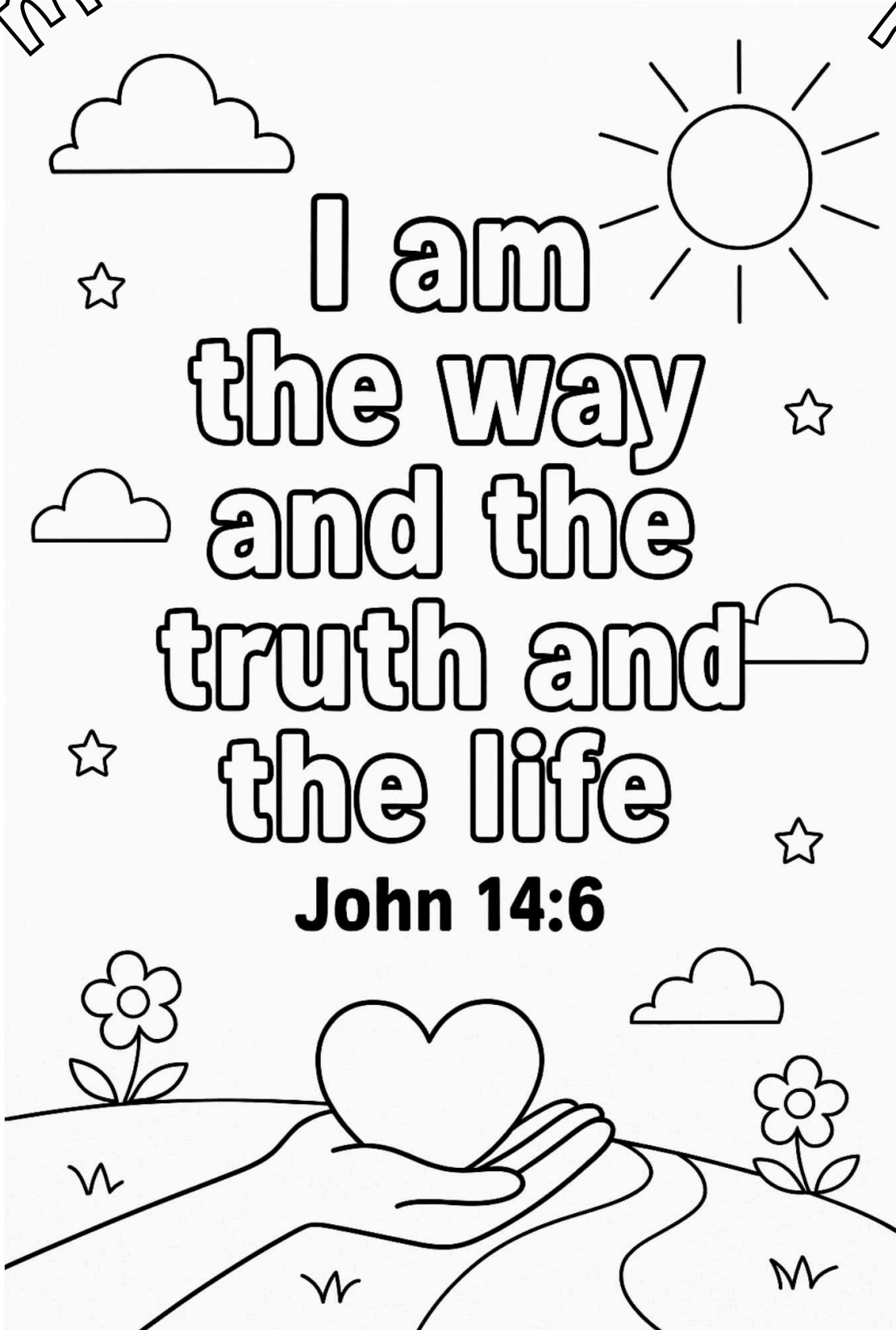
1. Do you think it is important to know WHY God created us?
