## WHAT WE'RE LEARNING

The book of Genesis begins with a beautiful story about how God made the world. At first, there was nothing at all—no light, no land, and no people. Then God began to create. God made light and darkness, the sky and the seas, and dry land with plants and trees. God filled the world with fish in the water, birds in the sky, and animals on the land.

Last of all, God made people. God made them special, in God's own image, and gave them the job of taking care of the world. God saw everything that was made and said it was very good.

After six days of creating, God rested, showing that rest is important too. The story of creation teaches that the world is good, that God loves what God has made, and that people are an important part of God's wonderful creation.
