GIVING CHANGES YOU

- *Dave said, “Live like no one else, so that later you can live and give like no one else.” What does that mean to you?*
- *You don’t “give to get,” but holding what God has given you with an open hand is what allows God to give us more of what He knows we need. Where have you seen that in your life?*
- *Read Proverbs 22:25. Dave said, “The peace in financial peace comes from outrageous generosity.” Generous people prosper because when they give they become selfless, which makes them likable. Think of someone you know like this. What is something about them that draws you to them?*

GENEROSITY COULD CHANGE AMERICA


- *We are happiest and most fulfilled when we are giving. What would happen if “we the people” relied less on the government and we just started taking care of “we the people?”*

OUTRAGEOUS GENEROSITY

- *According to Giving USA, last year individuals gave over \$286B to charity. That's an average of \$2,514 per household, just 4% of the average income. If we increased that just to 4.4%, we could eradicate hunger in America. Yet we choose to spend more on taking care of our pets than it would take to feed every hungry child in America. Why do we do this?*

WHY DOES GOD TELL US TO GIVE

- *The Bible mentions the concept of giving over 2100 times. That's more than twice as often as He mentions faith, love, or prayer. Why do you suppose God tells us to give so often in Scripture?*
 - *God is a giver. In John 3:16, God gave his only begotten Son. How do we become willing to give as much as He did? How can we call ourselves Christians (like Christ), if we are not willing to give sacrificially like Him?*
 - *The ultimate debt forgiveness is what God did by giving His son for us. Think of what you are doing with that gift. Are you serving? Blessing others? Leading the lost to Christ?*
 - *Would the average person know you are a Christian by the way you serve, bless others, or lead? Would the people closest to you see Christian values in the way you steward your money?*

ENCOURAGE

Read Genesis 12:3 and Proverbs 11:25. You are blessed in order to be a blessing. God has given you a generous heart so that you can refresh others. In return, God has promised He will refresh us. Go forth this week knowing that God has instilled in you a generous heart and be refreshed in that knowledge.



ASK

CHALLENGE

Read Proverbs 11:25 daily this week and begin giving generously and see how that changes you. Strive to be “blessed to be a blessing” to someone this week. Look for the PEACE in financial peace by producing outrageous generosity out of habit. Because, generosity isn’t an act or an event. It’s a character quality. Practice it this week and see if it doesn’t become who you are.
