- *If the Church truly is the “hope of the world,” what does that mean for how we live Monday through Saturday?*

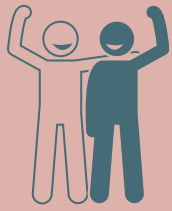
WE ARE BUILDING WITH JESUS TO REACH THE WORLD
