### SCRIPTURE

Read Matthew 1:1-2

### PASS IT ON

- What words, values, and priorities are you passing onto the next generation?
- What are some words, values, and priorities that you have from the previous generation that you need to stop from being passed on to the next one?

### IMPERFECT PEOPLE PASS IT ON

- What would it look like for you to take ownership of God's promises for your life?
- Abraham let fear lead him to try to accomplish God's plan for him on his own. Share a time when you have allowed fear to cause you to forget the promises that God has spoken to you? What were the results?
- Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob were all imperfect, yet God remained faithful through every generation. Is there an area of your past or a failure you've believed disqualifies you from being used by God? How does God's faithfulness change your perspective?

## MODEL WHAT YOU PASS ON

- If your faith became someone else's blueprint for following Jesus, what would you hope they learn from your example?
- In what ways can you actively invest in the next generation and share your faith with them?
- "The greatest legacy you will ever leave is the faith you pass on to the next generation." Is this truth lived out in your life? What legacy are you leaving? (financial security, well-educated, family traditions, etc.)



## ACT ON IT



### ENCOURAGE

Each of us has a name – but no matter what name you’re given, you are still a child of God. When you’re feeling discouraged, remember what God has done and who He says you are, in Him – He is faithful to complete His promises, by his might, generation after generation! – “I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me” (Philippians 4:13)



### ASK

This week, take some time to think through the areas of your life where you are lacking trust in God’s process, or showing impatience during a waiting season – read Habakkuk 2:3-4, bring it before God, and surrender it in prayer this week.



### CHALLENGE

Think of 1-3 people in your family, neighborhood, or workplace who doesn’t know God – Spread the Gospel: pray for an opportunity, step out in faith, tell them about something God has recently done for you.

## PRAYER

Pray for God to help each person trust His faithfulness and timing, surrender fear and impatience, and live out a faith that points the next generation and those around them toward Jesus.
