FAITH BEGINS WITH WHAT WE HEAR

- Rahab heard the same report as everyone in Jericho but she responded differently. As a Christ follower how should our response to the things in the world be different than those who don't believe?
- Read Romans 10:17. Share a time when you had to stand on the word of God and his promises, despite your circumstances (e.g., when your next step seems impossible, when fear/shame feels overwhelming, when you don't know what to do next, etc.).

FAITH BELIEVES GOD IS GREATER THAN WHAT WE SEE

- What is one situation where your perspective of God has become smaller than your circumstances? What would it look like to trust that God is greater than what you currently see?

FAITH MOVES US TO ACTION

- What is the difference in just believing in God and living out your faith as a fully devoted follower of Christ?
- Read James 2:24-26. Name a time that your faith moved you to action and your actions bore fruit.

FAITH CHANGES THE FUTURE

- Rahab was the first person in her family tree to choose to have faith in God. And God used her in the lineage of Jesus. Is there someone in your family tree who helped change the direction of your family's faith? If not, how can YOU be that person for your family?

ACT ON IT



ENCOURAGE

The enemy wants you to believe your past is your final chapter, But God is still writing your story. Have faith, take the next step, and allow the Holy Spirit to lead you (Jeremiah 29:11, Proverbs 3:5-6).



ASK

Where is God asking you to trust Him more than your circumstances? What's one next step of faith He may be calling you to take this week?



CHALLENGE

This week, identify one area where you've been allowing your past to define you instead of God's truth. Surrender it in prayer — take one tangible step that reflects your new identity in Christ (ask your group to name their next step).

PRAYER

Use the following prayer prompts with your group:

- Redirect our focus from distractions
- Surrender control and trust in God's plan
- Walk in newness with the Armor of God
