

Introduction

- Have you ever asked, "God do You really want ME to do this?
 What if others don't like ME? But others are more qualified than ME? Why ME?" Why not you?
- Pastor Elmer said, "Your resume doesn't impress God..." How does that make you feel? What ways are you trying to impress God?
- Nothing outside of Jesus can bring us to God. What other ways other than through Jesus have you or are you trying to get to God?

God's Grace at Work

- Moses missed out on entering the promised land all because he took matters into his own hands. What is God telling YOU to do, and what are you actually doing? Share a time where you thought you were disobedient but God still provided
- Have you ever felt the pressure of making water come out of the rock for thirsty people? Isaiah 48 reads, "God will not share His glory with anyone." How does it make you feel to know that it's not you, but God who makes the water flow?
- Moses used his staff as a security blanket. What is your security blanket? When do you tend to take matters into your own hands instead of relying on God? Examples?

• When you see results in your life, do you give God glory first or pat yourself on the back for your accomplishments?

Peace without Answers

- Are you carrying weight that was never intended for you to carry, or even to understand? What weight are you carrying that has been hard for you to put down?
- We sometimes seek peace in substances, drugs, alcohol, pornography, relationships, and sex, yet nothing changes on the inside. We should simply remember that "our Redeemer lives". What are some of your favorite truths of God? When have you blindly trusted God?
- Do your feelings come out of your human emotions (reactive) or are they evidence of the fruits of the spirit? How do you know?
- Pastor Elmer talked about how it was only when he turned to scripture, that he was able to overcome. What pain, worry, and/or anxiety are you holding onto? What are practical ways or scriptures that help remind you that God's grace is sufficient?

We are Called

- God can work through us even in the little moments. Can you say "I am here," at all times of the day? (at work, with your family, on the computer, etc.) If not, what is causing you to be too busy to answer the daily callings of God?
- God doesn't call us to be experts. He calls us to simply be servants that respond to His call. What task is God telling you to do? Are you hesitant? Explain.
- How do you feel about this? Lean into the pain and let it allow you to serve others despite the pain.
- When we respond to the Lord, everything you need to finish the task will be supplied by Him. Do you let the world tell you what you are capable of or do you trust God to guide your steps?

ENCOURAGE

While prepping for a new year, it's easy to start coming up with a list of things we can do to ensure the next year will be better than the last. But as the year starts to unfold, we get distracted or discouraged because our plans don't go as expected. For 2024, leave the resolution list alone and find rest in knowing that all we need to do is be willing and available for the plans God has for us.
